Please note that Sr. High band is a curricular/academic class.

ASSESSMENT

Sectional preparation/attendance.....50%
(see enclosed rubric)

Sectionals are an essential part of the curriculum. Most students are **scheduled** for sectionals during study halls. Students in rotating sectionals should attend sectionals except:

- a. if they are below a "C" average in the class that their sectional is scheduled.
- b. if a test is scheduled for that class period

First marking period music assessment will be on the field show music.

Rehearsal/Performance participation.....50%

This portion of the grade includes classroom participation (having your music and instrument) and attendance at all (after school) rehearsals and performances. If you need to miss an after school rehearsal, I NEED A SIGNED NOTE FROM YOUR PARENT/GUARDIAN PRIOR TO THE ABSENCE.
